PREFACE

Description of the Data

This publication contains Nevada employment data, payroll data and average wages by industry and county for calendar year 2008. These data were compiled from quarterly employment and wage reports submitted by employers subject to Chapter 612 of the Nevada Revised Statutes on Unemployment Compensation (NRS612). The Research and Analysis Bureau produces this information in cooperation with the Bureau of Labor Statistics/Quarterly Census of Employment and Wages (QCEW) program. Quarterly average employment data have been tabulated by industry according to the North American Industry Classification System (NAICS) Manual on a statewide and county basis. Payroll data represent the total wages paid by the establishments during the period. Average weekly wage data are computed from employment and total wages reported by all establishments. Average weekly wages are not to be confused with the “prevailing” wage rates in various industries.

Definition of Covered Employment and Total Payrolls

Covered employment is the number of workers employed by employers subject to NRS612 during the pay period that includes the 12th day of the month. Excluded from coverage are self-employed, railroad workers, unpaid family workers, elected officials, agricultural labor on small farms, employees in small non-profit organizations, commissioned real estate workers, and some workers in religious organizations. For a complete list, please refer to NRS612.

The payroll data used in this publication includes all wages and salaries paid to covered employees by their employers including bonuses, commissions, tips and cash values or remuneration received in any medium other than cash. The total payrolls include both taxable and nontaxable wages. The average annual wage is the numeric calculation of total payrolls divided by average annual employment. The average annual wage is divided by 52 weeks to reflect the average weekly wage.

Industry classification

Industry information is provided under the North American Industry Classification System (NAICS). This represents a major departure from the Standard Industry Classification (SIC) system for identifying industries that has been used in the U.S. for decades. Among other things, the NAICS coding change makes possible the direct comparison of employment data between the United States, Canada and Mexico. The system also reflects the transformation of the economy from goods producing to one that is more service based. In addition, changes have been made to improve industry detail, coverage; definitions that better clarify classification concepts and classification of individual activities. The NAICS coding scheme is NOT comparable to the SIC coding scheme at any level, except at the total statewide or county employment level. Confidentiality

The Research and Analysis Bureau withholds publication of data when necessary to protect the identity and data of cooperating employers. Since QCEW gets reports from every employer in Nevada, there are many cases where QCEW detailed data could consist of a single employer. Data are withheld or "suppressed" in this publication for any geographic level in which there are fewer than three (3) firms or in which the employment of a single firm accounts for over 80 percent of the industry. Data are also withheld where there is reason to believe that the “fewer than three” rule would not prevent disclosure of information pertaining to an individual firm.

Totals at the industry level for Nevada and the counties include the nondisclosable data suppressed within the detailed tables. However, these totals cannot be used to reveal the suppressed data.

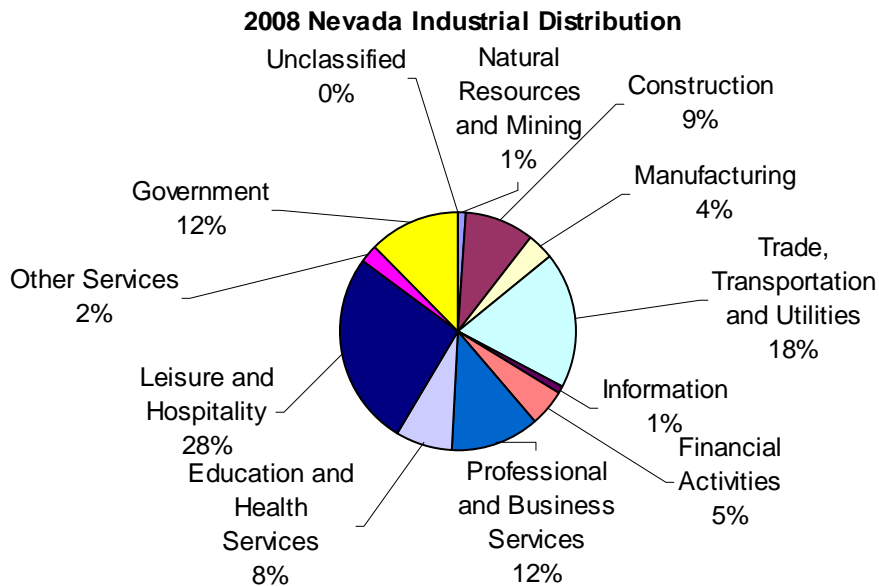
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NAICS INDUSTRY STRUCTURE

The NAICS industry hierarchy classifies data to the six-digit level. The first level consists of the Goods Producing and Service Producing Clusters. Below this is the Super Sector Level. The third layer is the Sector level. Data for the State of Nevada, Clark and Washoe counties is published at the Sector Level and for most of the 3-digit Sub-Sectors with additional detail for selected NAICS industries. Data for the rest of Nevada's counties is published at the Super Sector level only.

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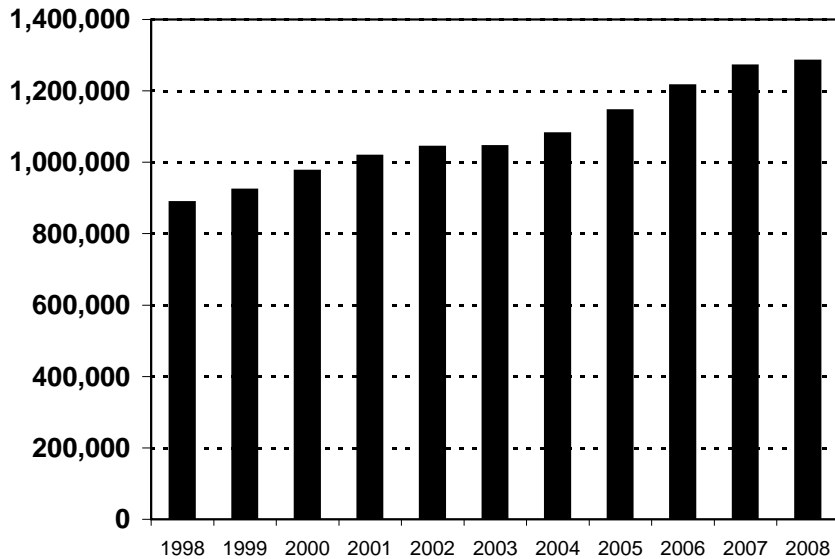
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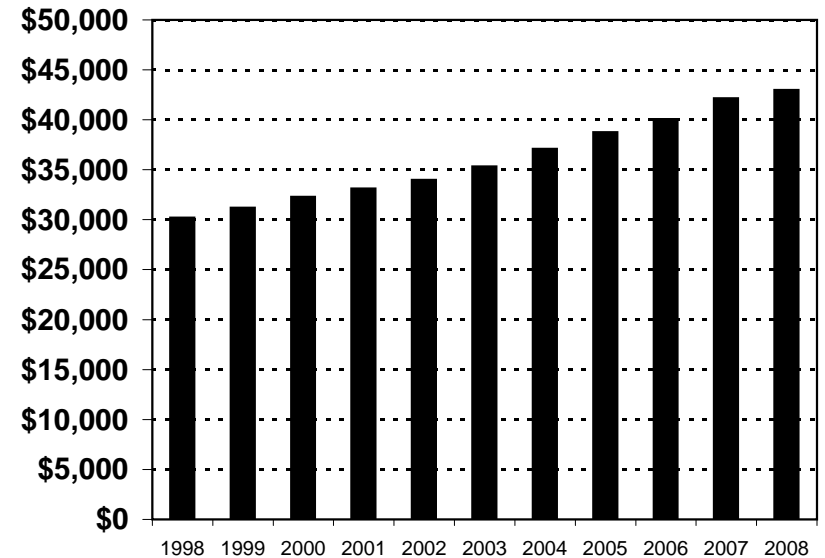

AVERAGE ANNUAL WAGES 1998-2008



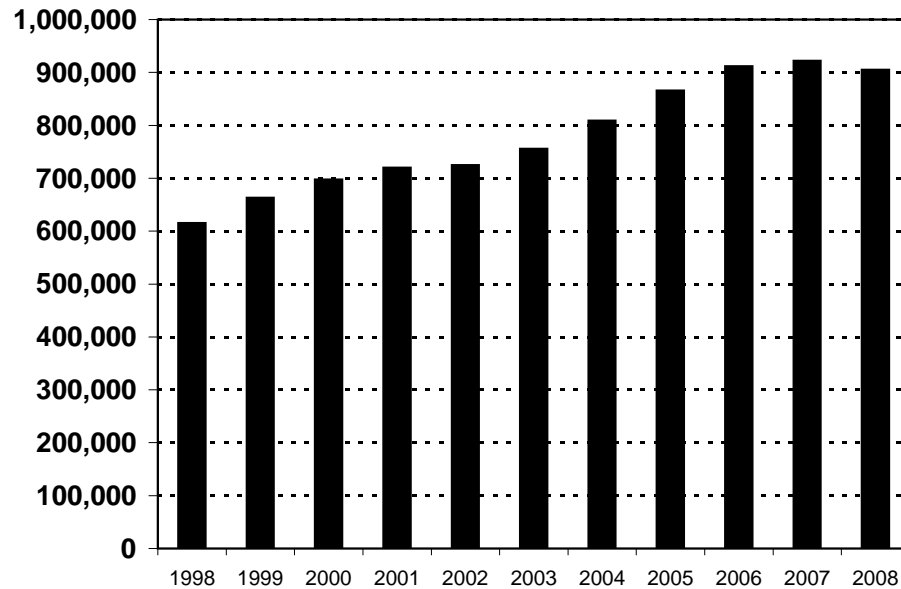
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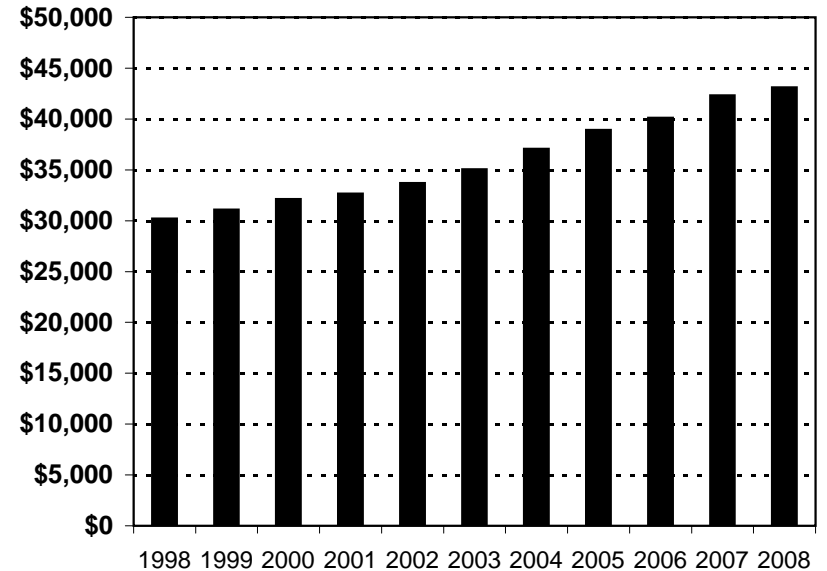

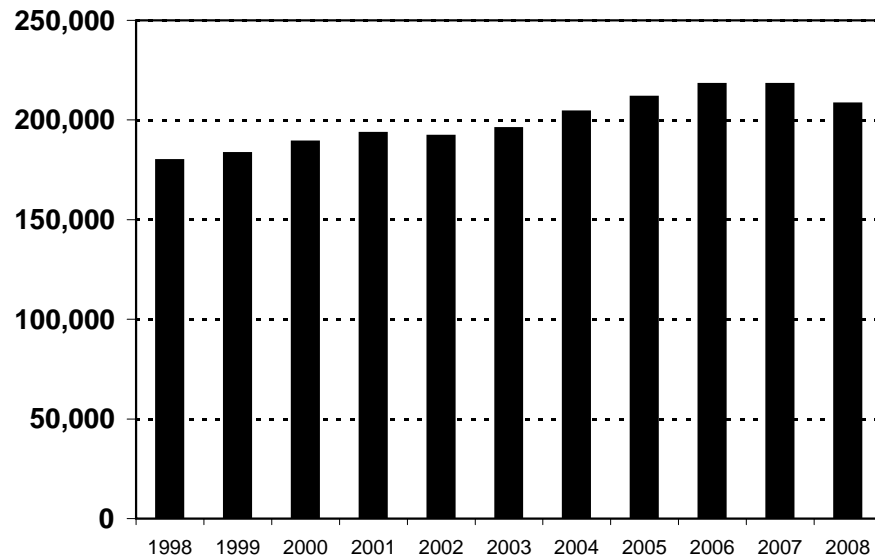

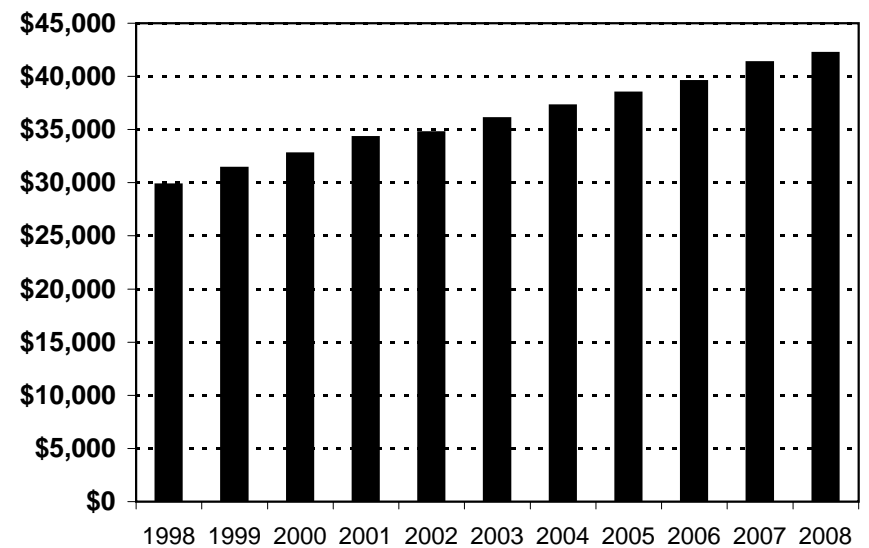
