

Nevada's Top Export Products to China 2017



- Information from the International Trade Administration shows China is the fourth largest export economy in the Silver State for 2017. Nevada's top export commodity to China is computer and electronic products (e.g., this industry comprises establishments primarily engaged in manufacturing and/or assembling electronic devices, computers and equipment). In 2017 this commodity represented 38 percent of the State's total exports to China (\$804 million), at \$306 million.
- Exports of mineral and ore products (e.g. primarily gold and other mining activities) totaled \$255 million, 32 percent of all exports to China.
- Chemical manufacturing (e.g., butane, ethylene, and propene) made from refined petroleum or liquid hydrocarbons were Nevada's third largest export to China accounting for 13 percent (\$107 million) of total exports.
- Other exports included: food manufactures (\$44 million), electrical equipment/appliances/components (\$22 million), machinery except electrical (\$20 million), transportation equipment (\$10 million), miscellaneous manufactured commodities (e.g., gaming equipment) (\$9 million), agricultural products (\$8 million), and plastic and rubber products (\$3 million).
